## VISIT TO AXE VALLEY WILDLIFE PARK, AXMINSTER THURSDAY 25<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2023

Dear Parents / Carers

We have arranged a **visit to Axe Valley Wildlife Park in Axminster** for all EYFS (Yr R) and KS1 pupils from Phoenix Class and Gruffalo Class on **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> May**. As part of our learning journey we have organised a trip to Axe Valley Wildlife Park to enable the children to explore and experience different animals. During our visit to the zoo we will have the opportunity for hands on experiences, a zoo trail and the chance to ask experienced members of staff some of our questions. We will also spend the day exploring the zoo and observing the many different animals.

The coach will **leave Shepton Beauchamp at 8.30am** and then proceed to St Mary and St Peter's, **children will need to arrive at school at 8.20am** to be registered and walk to the bus stop and will return for collection at usual school pick up time 3.15pm. Morning and After School Club will be running as usual on that day.

A school packed lunch will be provided for all children unless you opt out. Please email office@threesaints.bwmat.org with your choice of CHEESE, HAM or NO PACKED LUNCH ASAP, by MONDAY 15TH MAY at the latest.

We are asking for a **voluntary contribution of £18.50 per child** to make the trip possible. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding we are requesting a £8.00 voluntary contribution towards the trip. Please log in to **Parent Pay to give your consent and to make your payment by Thursday May 18th**. Please ask in the School Office if you are unsure of your Pupil Premium eligibility. If you are unable to use Parent Pay you will need to send your contribution to the School Office where you will be given a full consent form to complete.

PLEASE NOTE: If insufficient contributions are received, it may be necessary to cancel this trip.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform, but they are welcome to wear comfortable shoes such as trainers. All children will need a waterproof coat in case of showers and suncream in case of sunshine and a refillable water bottle in a small rucksack that children can easily carry and a packed lunch if you opt out of the school packed lunch.

We hope that the children will have a fabulous time.
