KS2 Magdalen Farm River Study Field Trip

Dear Parents/ Carers – Seymour Class and Oak Class

We have arranged a visit to **Magdalen Farm, Winsham** on **Wednesday 25th May**. The day will focus on studying rivers and streams by actually getting in one! Magdalen Farm has a beautiful, safe and shallow section of the River Axe where we can safely wade in to enjoy a selection of fun activities such as: Dipping and Identifying river-life, a Scientific Study, Teddy Bear Raft Racing and learning River Terminology.

The coach will leave soon after registration and will return for collection as usual at the end of the school day. After School Clubs will be running as usual on that day.

Children should wear their **own clothes**, appropriate for a muddy, wet day in a river – so the older, the better! All children will need a **waterproof coat** in case of showers and **Wellington boots**.

Children will need a **packed lunch** and a **full water bottle** in a small rucksack that they can easily carry. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, you are able to book a packed lunch (ham or cheese) via Parent Pay when you consent to the trip (see below). If you have any difficulties, please speak to the School Office. If you are unsure of your FSM eligibility, please do ask in the office as it is very quick and simple to check.



We are extremely grateful to FOSS and PFA for subsidising this trip. We are asking for a **voluntary contribution of £12.00 per child** to make the trip possible. Please log in to **Parent Pay to give your consent and to make your voluntary contribution by 23rd May**. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding and you wish to access this, no voluntary contribution is required. Please ask in the School Office if you are unsure of your Pupil Premium eligibility. If you are unable to use Parent Pay you will need to send your contribution to the School Office where you will be given a full consent form to complete. *PLEASE NOTE: If insufficient contributions are received, it may be necessary to cancel this trip.*
