Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Summer Term 2025! I hope that you have all had a lovely Easter break. Thank you so much for all your support and engagement with your children's learning!

Summer Term means hopefully warmer weather – but you never know! So, please ensure that your child has a hat and a light raincoat, in their bag every day. Suncream can be applied in the morning – we prefer not to have it in school if possible. However, it is essential that the children understand the importance of sun protection and we support sensible use.

Just a few reminders for you:

- Our PE days are timetabled on Monday afternoons and Wednesday mornings.
- Please could you make sure that all uniform items, PE kits, water bottles and lunchboxes are **named**. Name tags and iron-on labels are great but just initials with a Sharpie-type pen would help us enormously in returning lost items to their owner.
- All long hair must be tied up whilst at school, and no jewellery to be worn please. If your child has ear piercings, these must be small, plain studs and not to be worn into school on P.E. days.
- Please continue to encourage your child to share books and read with you. A story together, talking about a favourite book, using information texts – these moments are so important. We want to build a love of reading as well as an understanding of the power and essential role of words, in our everyday lives.
- **Fruit** is provided daily for all Phoenix Class. You are welcome to send in individual fruit for your child in addition to this.



Our KS1 topic this term is **'School Days'** – a history-based project which looks at our school and its place in the village. If you or members of your family, have any memories of the school, we would love to hear them. Our curriculum is knowledge and skills based and to enhance their learning - there are knowledge organisers on the school website, which explain more. However, just ask for a printed copy if you would like one.

We will also study 'Plants and Animal Life Cycles' – science topics, 'Street View' – an art project and 'Chop, Slice, Mash' – a food-based DT project.

We are also excited to be going to see the **Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra** and take part in their KS1 workshop at Yeovil on **Tuesday 13**th **May**. We are learning the song and thinking about the different instruments that we might see and hear. Link below for the curious!
