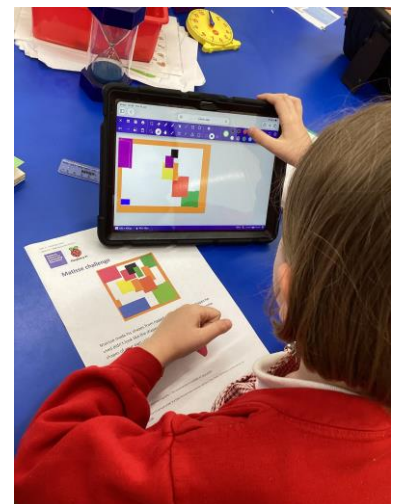
The next few weeks are very busy with lots of exciting learning and events – please have a look at the calendar below.

Phoenix Class

This week, Phoenix Class proudly completed their English unit on Wolves. The children created their own non-fiction booklets, each one packed with interesting facts and thoughtful illustrations. In Maths, Key Stage One have been busy practising telling the time. Through lots of hands-on activities with clocks, they've grown more confident in making and reading different times. Reception have been exploring numbers to 20, learning how each number is made of "10 and a bit." In RE, we explored the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant and talked about why forgiveness matters. The children then created a beautiful "chain of forgiveness," linking together their ideas about kindness, understanding, and making things right.

On both visits, staff have received very positive feedback about our pupils, particularly for how well they conduct themselves during sessions. One group even had the exciting opportunity to learn the butterfly stroke this week and were praised for their excellent questions, enthusiasm, and effort throughout.
