Phoenix Class

Phoenix Class blasted off into British Science Week by investigating whether food can grow on the moon. After making predictions and setting up our experiment, we're watching closely to see what happens next. In DT, children explored mechanisms and levers to create moving cards. Some were a challenge, but their determination was brilliant. Reception have been busy learning about animals and their babies in their Ready, Steady, Grow topic, drawing and labelling lots of adorable pairs. KS1 have begun their journey into the world of three famous Queens, matching clues and even creating their own clues for a King or Queen.

Gryphon Class

It has been a busy couple of weeks in Gryphon Class! In Geography, we've been learning about different types of mountains - fold, fault-block, dome, volcanic and plateau mountains - and exploring the basic processes that form them. In English, we've been creating imaginative stories inspired by our own invented "lost things." The children have shown wonderful creativity, bringing their unique ideas to life through detailed and expressive writing. We've also just finished our latest unit in French. The class can now say which activities they can and can't do, using simple French sentences with growing confidence. In science we looked at ways to melt ice faster, we got through a lot of ice cubes! We crushed ice, bashed ice, we added salt to ice, and we put ice in different locations. The children really enjoyed syringing up the melted water. Well done, Gryphon class - fantastic learning all round!

We are so proud of all the children who took part in the Stand up and Speak competition. They all spoke with such confidence and enthusiasm. It made choosing our winners very difficult!
