We are very excited to welcome you on Thursday for our Breakfast and Number morning. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be ready to go!

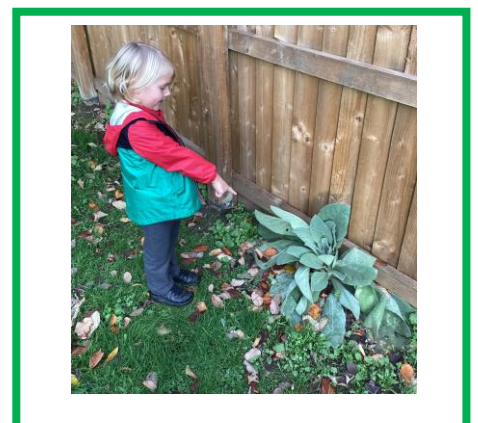

Gryphon Class Parliament Visit

This week, Gryphon class were visited
by Tomas Williams who is part of
Parliament's Education Service. We
learnt more about democracy and the
rule of law in our country.

Our school council explained the
difference between House of
Commons and House of Lords:

"House of Commons is the first part
of the process to create a bill of Law.
The MPs will discuss whether it is
good or not, then finally vote yes or
no to hand to the House of Lords.
House of Lords is the second part of
the process and is when the Lords vote
on a piece of paper (Bill) and then
select AYE (which means yes) or no.
In the house the seats are red."

Phoenix Class News

Phoenix class have had another busy week of learning! In Science,
children took their Habitats lesson outside to investigate things
that are living, non-living and used to be alive. This sparked lots
of thoughtful discussion, including observations that the
climbing frame was made of wood so once came from a living tree.
In English, we are continuing to enjoy Ning and the Night
Spirits. Inspired by events in the story, children created
decorations, held their own parade and reflected on how characters
might have felt in the moment. In PSHE we have been celebrating
differences and this week children enjoyed finding out and
celebrating things they had in common with their classmates

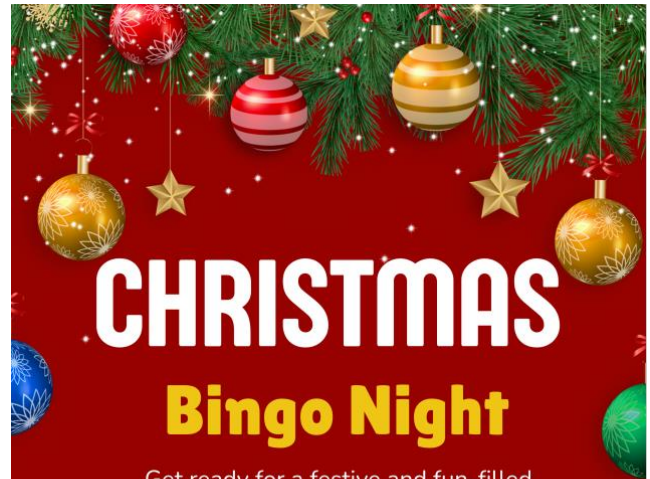
