Outdoor Learning Day

Today was our first outdoor learning day with Pachamama's. Shepton and what an experience!

The children moved through a lively circuit of activities as we explored Misty Mountains and Winding Rivers.

They created their own miniature rivers, floated handmade rafts downstream, and worked together to produce a large collaborative river artwork using a variety of materials. There was plenty of mud, plenty of laughter, and we rounded off the session perfectly with warm hot chocolate around the fire ring.

Phoenix Class

Phoenix Class have been diving into the magical story The Magic Bed and are busy planning their own adventure tales to write next week. In Maths KS1 have been adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers using different methods and equipment. In Science we explored the properties of materials and enjoyed sorting them in different ways. In RE we are learning about Judaism and the Torah. This week children learned about Simchat Torah and made colourful flags to celebrate. Reception children are doing brilliantly in phonics and are now starting to learn some special friend sounds with some super Fred Talk to read words.

Gryphon Class

In science this week, we continued exploring states of matter by focusing on the three forms water can take: ice, liquid water, and steam. The children melted ice cubes in the classroom to observe how solids change into liquids, and they also measured the temperatures of ice, cold water, warm water, and hot water to compare how heat affects each state. It was a hands-on, engaging way to deepen their understanding of how materials change.
